Curriculum Vitae

Mr. Hale is an investigator of 30-years service in Federal law enforcement, the intelligence community and polygraphy. He holds a current Top Secret security clearance with the Federal government. A graduate of the nationally acclaimed Texas Department of Public Safety's Law Enforcement Polygraph School, Hale is also trained in the less intrusive methods of the Reid School of Interview and Interrogation and is certified in Scientific Content (Statement) Analysis by the Laboratory for Scientific Interrogation (*LSI-SCAN*.) As a licensed private-practitioner he has offices in Laredo, San Antonio and Houston, however, he also provides services throughout the United States and Latin America.

Hale is certified to conduct post-conviction sex-offender examinations by the Joint Polygraph Committee on Offender Testing in Texas, and nationally by the American Polygraph Association. As a Containment-Team Member, he has conducted numerous sex-offender examinations under contract for the Harris County Community Supervision and Corrections Department, under Court Order for the Harris County Standing Committee for the Board of Judges and in consultation with Psychological Treatment Providers.

Upbringing on both sides of the U.S.-Mexico border, as well as residency in Colombia and Bolivia, enable Hale to provide exclusive Spanish-speaking services with native fluency. With a Computer Science background, Hale serves Latin America as an expert for The Stoelting Company, the pioneers in the development of computerized polygraphs. Hale is a certified technical instructor and is available to give instruction regarding polygraphy.

Operating within the scope of the attorney-client privilege, Hale endeavors to verify truth or detect deception regarding allegations of arson, theft, embezzlement, infidelity, sex crimes, assault, police misconduct and other issues. Through the polygraph process Hale has revealed dishonesty in job applicants, employees, criminal suspects and law enforcement personnel. More importantly, he has exonerated defendants, reconciled troubled marriages, expedited divorces and recovered stolen properties. In 1999, as Chairman of the APA Ethics Committee, Hale received an Award of Merit for vindicating examiners accused of alleged improprieties.
